



ASSESS is the test and assessment creation module in TRACCESS.

ASSESS allows you to easily create, modify and delete questions and assessments. You can author questions and assessments using a Windows-based program or a browser with a server-based system. Windows-based authoring, which requires that software be installed on your PC, provides a powerful environment for creating simple and complex questions and assessments. The ASSESS browser-based authoring tool offers much of the functionality available in the Windows-based tool while enabling easy wide-scale deployment.

Within ASSESS you can create comprehensive assessments and then link them to a task within TRACCESS PERFORM. Employees can simply click on an icon in PERFORM to launch assessments. The results of the task knowledge assessment (scores) are stored within the employee's record. Assuming that the passing score was achieved, the knowledge component of the task is updated as complete. The observations of a coach or supervisor can also be scored and assuming that the passing score is achieved, the employee's record is updated in real time, certifying that the employee is now competent to perform the task to standard.

ASSESS houses thousands of banks of questions of various types (drag & drop, multiple choice, short answer, essay, survey, etc.), driven from a database where you can categorize the actual questions to a specific performance level, and then you can retrieve and re-use these questions, whenever you are assessing the knowledge or the capabilities.
